Kneidinger 1880 GmbH Warranty conditions 2016

- 1) These warranty conditions apply subordinate to our general delivery and business conditions, as published on www.kneidinger.at, which are recognized and accepted by you and which are basis for our business relationship.
- 2) Condition for any type of warranty claim upon Kneidinger 1880 is, that
 - the respective machine has been proven orderly handed over to the final customer (Take-over declaration complete filled and signed)
 - the final customer has been familiarised with the relevant Safety Regulations and the Owner Manuals.
- 3) Time of warranty is 12 month from date of delivery by dealer.
Please note, that in case of claim even the Kneidinger 1880 product can be claimed under warranty. General wearing parts are excluded from warranty. For, in course of this warranty repaired or replaced parts, warranty lapses during the original warranty period of the machine or the product.
- 4) Warranty repair has to be approved by Kneidinger 1880 in advance.
- 5) The justified work times are remunerated by Kneidinger 1880 hourly rate . Travel costs, auxiliary materials, oils, shipping costs and material which is not bought from Kneidinger 1880 or other expenses can not be covered.
- 6) Parts for warranty works are principlly invoiced in advance. If period of return is fulfilled and warranty claim is accepted by Kneidinger 1880, costs for parts and appropriate repair costs will be remunerated if required.
- 7) After repair work, defect parts and completed Kneidinger 1880 warranty application has to be sent to Kneidinger 1880 during 14 days . Too late received or incomplete warranty applications can not be processed and warranty voids.
- 8) The decision, if parts should be repaired or replaced, is up to Kneidinger 1880.
- 9) In case of Non-observance of operating regulations and assembly instructions, modification to the device or not properly hand over to the final customer, warranty is void!
- 10) As manufacturer we reserve the right, to make changes at any time. Therefor the details in technical documentations are non-binding and can be changed at any time.
- 11) These warranty conditions can be changed at any time. Applicable are the conditions which are current at time of damage. Warranty conditions can be requested any time.
- 12) The manufacturer declines any liability for damages resulting from operation of the plough for a purpose it has not been designed for. At the same time any claims, for compensation under Law of Product Liability in case of injury of involved or uninvolved persons or damage of their property, are void.
- 13) Furthermore any damages claim, in particular economic loss, between the manufacturer and other industrial entrepreneurs, are excluded. Claims for damages on basis of negligence, between other persons and the manufacturer, are excluded.
